

Why circular procurement?

Procurement is essential part loop Demand can change production (15-20% of GDP) Governments (& business) can focus demand

Money: Costs become revenues

Confidential paper - € 750.000 → + € 750.000

Discarded IT (cost per PC) - € 35 → € 12,50 → €0 → + € 30

Starting at the end: waste management


Pilot is easy, scaling is another story
