The PFAS Crisis – A Public Health and Environmental Emergency

- PFAS: the worst environmental and health crisis we face.
- >100,000 emitting industrial sites in Europe; > 20,000 hotspots.
- PFAS contaminate water, air, food, and soil, threatening human health and biodiversity.
- Annual clean-up costs exceed €100 billion, an unfair burden on society.
- **The science is clear**: PFAS are linked to cancer, infertility, immune disorders, and more.
- A Current regulations are failing, allowing industry deception and regulatory inertia.



A Legal Roadmap to address PFAS

- 1. Ban PFAS
- 2. Strengthen Soil Monitoring Laws
- 3. Adopt a Holistic Soil Health Strategy
- 4. Make Polluters Pay
- 5. End Industry Interference
- 6. Support Affected Communities
- 7. Promote Safer Alternatives
