<p>Department III 1 consists of six sections and roughly 100 scientific and administrative staff, charged with the advancement of the Circular Economy (sustainable consumption, eco-design, chemicals in products, waste prevention and recycling) and enforcement of relevant legislation. The main objectives are research and scientific policy advice in national, European and international networks for resource protection and a low-carbon Circular Economy as well as information of the general public on those topics.
