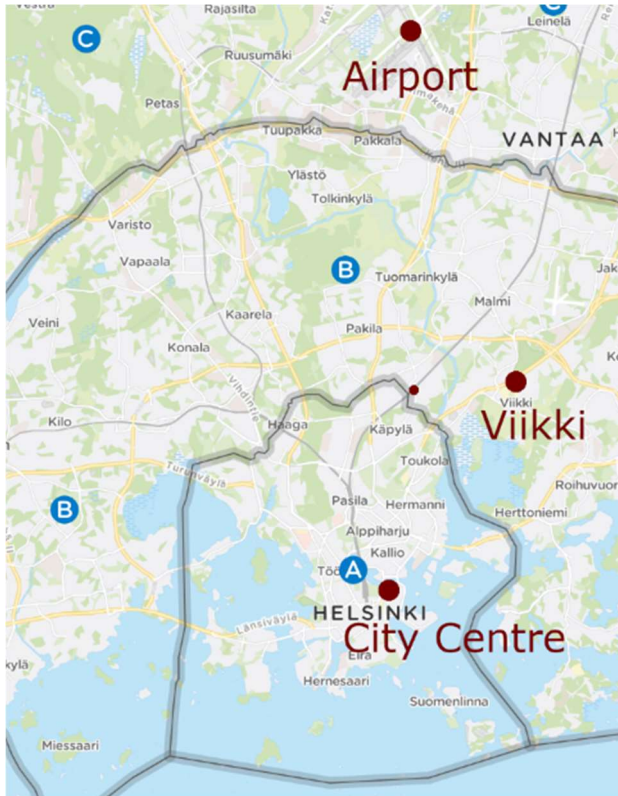

Venue

The meeting is held at the Finnish Environment Institute (Syke) located at the Viikki campus of the University of Helsinki. The meeting takes place at the institutes conference centre in the “A-building” at Latokartanonkaari 9, which also houses the Finnish Natural Resources Institute (Luke). The location of Viikki is highlighted on the map below.

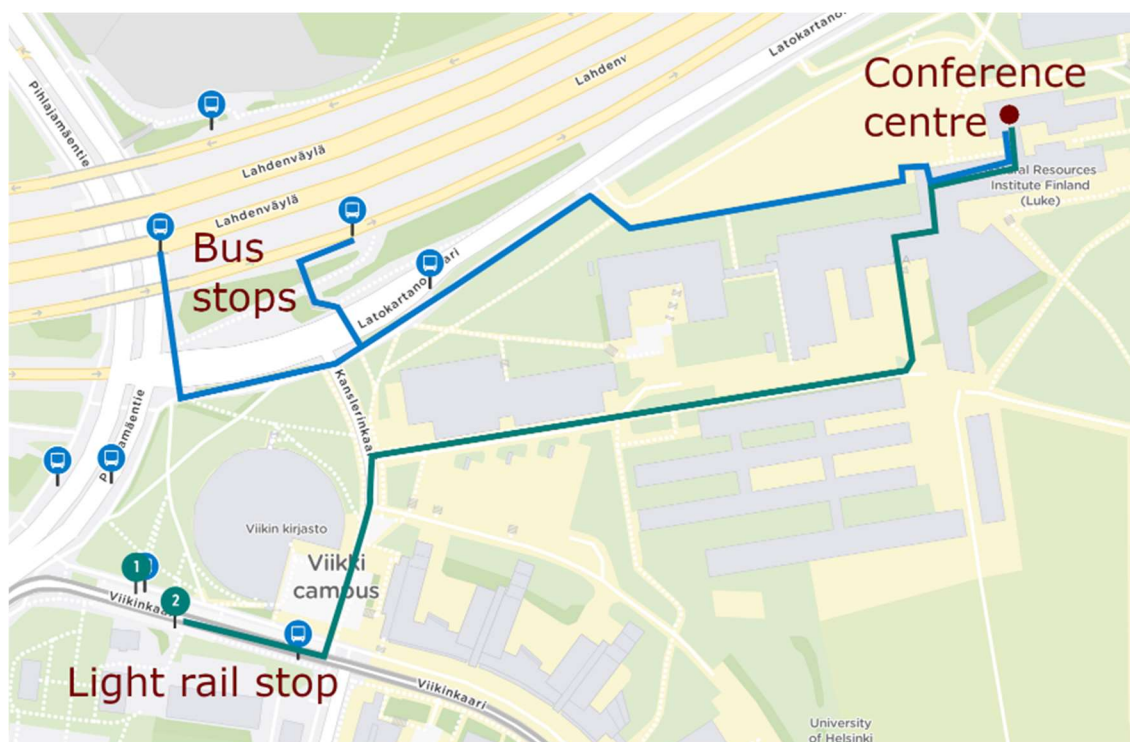
From the airport

To [get to the main railway station](#) in the city centre, take either the I or P-train from the airport. The trip takes about 40 minutes (ticket for zones ABC).

To [get directly to the Viikki campus](#), take the P-train from the airport to *Oulunkylä* station and switch to the light rail no 15 towards the east (destination *Itäkeskus*) and get off at the stop *Viikin tiedepuisto*. The trip takes about 40 minutes (ticket for zones BC).

From the city centre

To [get to Viikki from the main railway station](#) take a direct bus to Viikki and get off at stop *Viikki*. Suitable busses are number 75, 77, 717, 739, and 788. The bus trip takes about 30 minutes (ticket for zones AB).



Accommodation

To facilitate getting to and from Helsinki accommodation close to the main railway station in the city centre is recommendable, as there are no hotels close to the Viikki campus.

In addition to the hotel suggested below, there are many other hotels almost directly at the station and dozens more within walking distance.

Recommended hotel

Hotel Arthur.

Located about 500 meters from the main railway station.

A 10% discount for the meeting participants is available when making the reservation at Hotel Arthur by 10.2.2025 if booking via phone or email (see the link above for contact details). The discount code is ICPMM2025 and is valid for the nights between the 17th and 21st of February. Apparently, the code won't work if booking via the online system due to an ongoing IT-system overhaul. For check-ins after 6 pm the reservation needs to include credit card details. Cancellation is free of charge until 6pm on the day of arrival.
