As most of you are probably aware of, the Coordination Centre for Effects (CCE), as part of the ICP Modelling & Mapping, is currently in the transition process from the Dutch National Institute for Public Health and the Environment (RIVM) to the German Environment Agency (UBA). With this letter we would like to introduce the transition team of the UBA and we are happy to provide you with an update on a few items related to the ICP M&M's collaboration.

At the moment the transition team consist of five people: Markus Geupel, Christin Loran, Simone Richter, Thomas Scheuschner and Marion Wichmann-Fiebig. The main issues we are dealing with, currently, are the transfer of data and knowledge from RIVM to UBA, getting familiar with the main CLRTAP-options, - needs and -network and building up internal structures for a stable operation of the CCE. A new CCE website will be established soon and further information will follow.

We are confident that with collaboration and your help the ICP M&M community remains successful in developing the Critical Load approach further and keeping it relevant on the policy level.

We would like to kindly remind you that the current call for data was extended till 2019, as discussed at the last Task Force Meeting in Berne (April 2018). The proposed deadline of the call for data is **28 February 2019** to allow sufficient time for us to prepare results prior to the ICP M&M meeting (Madrid, probably beginning of April 2019). All NFC's are kindly asked to review their submission to the CCE and revise it, if necessary. The instructions and the data format are equal to the previous call for data.
